For over 50 years the Oceanport Lions Club has been helping not only sight impaired individuals but they have contributed in many ways to Oceanport residents through community donations. Here are some exciting programs that may be of interest for you or someone you know.

1. The club has information for low vision individuals.
2. The club also does vision screening.
3. On November 16th the Oceanport Lions Club will make a donation to the Oceanport School System.
4. There are several organizations including the state of New Jersey that will assist you with sight friendly devices including a talking books program. We can help you connect to the low vision services available.

Oceanport Lions Vision Screening & Screening Program for Accurate Detection

SPOT accurately detects the potential of these common vision problems:

- Myopia (nearsightedness)
- Hyperopia (farsightedness)
- Astigmatism (blurred vision)
- Anisometropia (unequal refractive power)
- Strabismus (eye misalignment)
- Anisocoria (unequal refractive power)

In 2015, the Oceanport Lions began to donate their time and energy to perform Annual Vision Screenings for pre-k and early elementary children in Monmouth County schools, including:

- Wolf Hill School in Oceanport
- St. Jerome's School in West Long Branch
- Lenna W. Conrow School in Long Branch
- Morris Avenue School in Long Branch
- Joseph M. Ferraina ECLC in Long Branch

Since 2015 the Oceanport Lions Club has performed vision screenings on over a thousand students! All vision screenings are provided free of charge by volunteers of the Oceanport Lions Club.
